1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) & Public Health Visits and Orders

During the reporting period the MOL conducted one site visit to St. George campus to investigate an employee complaint and one site visit to UTSC to investigate a Work Refusal. The

Ministry also communicated with the University regarding an employee illness at St. George campus and employee injuries at St. George and UTSC. No orders were issued.

2. Regulatory Visits
